
Please Note: After installation, extra hardware and accessories may be left due to kits being used on multiple products.

#### To Install Glass (Figure 1)

## **Component Parts**

- A Fixture
- H Glass
- I Studs (2)
- J Glass Brackets (2)
- K Knurled Balls (2)
- 1. Carefully unpack the fixture from the carton.
- 2. Remove knurled balls (K) and glass brackets (J) from studs (I). Parts ship installed.
- 3. Slide glass (H) into fixture (A).
- 4. Place glass brackets (J) onto studs (I) and secure with knurled balls (K).

*Note*: Be sure bent section of glass bracket (*J*) is over glass (*H*).

### To Mount Fixture to Wall (Figure 2)

#### **Component Parts**

A FixtureB Mounting Bracket

C Anchors (4)

D #10 Screws (4)


E Cupped Washer

F Ground Screw

G #8 Black Screws (2)

# Caution: Be sure power is off at the main breaker box prior to installation.

- 1. Place the mounting bracket (B) over the electrical box being sure to hold it plumb and level. With a pencil, mark the location of all mounting holes in the mounting bracket (B) on the wall behind. Set mounting bracket aside.
- Drill 1/4" holes in the locations marked on the wall. For holes using anchors, place the tapered end of the anchors (C) into the holes and gently tap them flush to the wall using a light weight hammer.



- 3. Thread the wires in the electrical box through the hole in the mounting bracket (B) while moving the bracket into position. Using the 1" #10 screws (D), screw the bracket securely to the wall. Be careful not to over-tighten or strip the anchors.
- 4. Using two machine screws (not provided) fasten the mounting bracket (B) to the electric box.

**Note:** A new electric box comes with screws. When replacing an existing fixture, retain screws for use with the new fixture.

- 5. Hold the fixture (A) close to the mounting bracket (B) and using suitable wire connectors (not provided) connect fixture wires to supply wires (white to white and black to black). Partially install cupped washer (E) and ground screw (F) to mounting bracket (B). Run a pigtail lead from the ground screw (F) toward the electrical box and connect all ground wires (bare copper or green to bare copper or green).
  - Caution: Make sure wire connectors are twisted on securely, and no bare wires are exposed.
- 6. Carefully tuck all wires behind the fixture (A) and inside the mounting bracket (B) and place the fixture (A) firmly onto bracket (B) and fasten with #8 black screw (H) on one side.
- 7. Install remaining black screw (H) into other side of fixture (A) attaching it to mounting bracket (B).
- 8. Restore electricity at main breaker
