# To Prepare Fixture for Installation (Figure 1)

## Component Parts

- A Bottom Assembly
- B Canopy
- C Screws (2)
- D Socket

## Caution: Be sure power is off at the main breaker box prior to installation

- 1. Carefully unpack the fixture from the carton.
- Loosen the two screws (C) located next to the socket (D) and turn the bottom assembly (A) counter clockwise until the heads of the screws (C) are located at the larger diameter of the slot and remove from the canopy (B). It is not necessary to remove the screws.
- 3. Save all parts for later use.

# To Install Fixture (Figure 2)


#### Component Parts

- B Canopy
- E Ground Screw
- F Cross Bar
- G Threaded Stud (2)
- H Barrel Knobs (2)


# Caution: Be sure power is off at the main breaker box prior to installation.

- 1. Thread studs (G) through appropriate holes in cross bar (F) to match hole centers in canopy (B). Move ground screw (E) to another available threaded hole if necessary.
- Using two machine screws (not provided) fasten cross bar (F)
  to the electric box using outer oval holes to orient fixture to
  desired hanging position. Note: A new electric box comes with
  screws. When replacing an existing fixture, retain the screws for
  use with the new fixture.
- 3. Using suitable wire connectors (not provided); connect fixture wires to supply wires (white to white and black to black). Run a pigtail lead from crossbar ground screw (E) to the junction box and connect all ground wires (bare copper or green to bare copper). **Caution:** Make sure wire connectors are twisted on securely, and no bare wire is exposed.
- 4. Slide fixture canopy (B) over threaded studs and push firmly to ceiling, making sure that no wires are pinched between fixture canopy and ceiling. Fasten with barrel knobs (H). Be sure studs (G) are fully seated in barrel knobs (H).




# To Install Bulb & Bottom Assembly (Figure 3 & 4)

### Component Parts

- A Bottom Assembly
- C Screws (2)
- I Socket
- J Bulb (Included)
- K Washer
- 1. Install light bulb (J). Be careful not to touch bulb with bare hands; oil from the hands will dramatically reduce bulb life.
- 2. Raise bottom assembly (A) over socket (I) aligning holes in washer (K) so the washer keyed ring goes over screws (C).
- 3. Turn washer (K) clockwise until it stops. Tighten two screws (C) until snug against washer (K) (Figure 4).
- 4. Restore electricity at main breaker.
