Please Note:

- All Kuzco LED fixtures come with pre-wired LED module(s).
- Unless instructed to do so, please do not touch any part of the LED module(s) as any unnecessary contact with the module could cause permanent damage.
- For dimming, an ELV (Electronic Low Voltage) type of dimmer is required.
- 1. Remove the fixture from its original packaging. Next, remove the mounting plate (1c) from within the canopy (2a) by un-threading the two nuts (2b). Secure the mounting plate (1c) to the junction box (1a) with screws (1e) provided in the hardware package.
- **2.** Before you mount the canopy to the mounting plate select the desired length you wish the pendant to hang. To shorten or lengthen the pendant (3a) just remove or add conduit sections (2c) by threading clockwise for adding and counter clockwise for removing. Next, feed the lead wires (2d) up through the conduit and into the canopy (2a).
- 3. Once this is complete, place the diffuser (3b) into the fixture. Slightly bend and slide one side of the diffuser (3b) first, then push the other side to succesfully place inside. This will secure the diffuser to the canopy.
- 4. You are now ready to mount the canopy. First, connect all wires correctly black to black "L", white to white "N" and the ground wire with provided marrettes (1b) from the hardware package. Align the threaded studs (1d) with the holes on the surface of the canopy (2a). Next, push the canopy (2a) to the mounting plate (1c) thread on the two nuts (2b) on to the threaded studs (1d). This will secure the canopy to the mounting plate.
- **5.** You have now completed the installation of your fixture, enjoy.
