

## ASSEMBLING THE FIXTURE (Fig.1).1. Shut off the power at the circuit breaker box. Remove old fixture and all hardware from Junction Box.

- 2. Carefully unpack your new fixture and lay out all the parts on a clear area. Take care not to lose any small parts necessary for installation.
- 3. Thread the two Studs (A) about 1/4" into the pre-drilled holes in the Crossbar spaced the same distance apart as the holes in the fixture (B).
- 4. Attach the Crossbar to the Junction Box with the two Junction Box Screws as shown. The side of the Crossbar marked "GND" must face out.
- 5. While holding the column assembly towards the ceiling, connect the electrical wires as Shown in Fig.2, making sure that all wire nuts are secured. You may have to wrap the connections with electrical tape. If your outlet has a ground wire (green or bare copper), connect the fixture ground wire to it. Otherwise connect fixture's ground wire directly to the Crossbar with the green screw provided. After wires are connected, tuck them carefully inside the Junction Box
- 6. Put the lamp body (B) onto the junction box, aligning screws on Crossbar with mounting holes in canopy and lock it securely with the ball nut (J).
- 7. Install the light bulbs in accordance with the fixture specifications NOTE: DO NOT EXCEED THE SPECIFIED WATTAGE!
- 8. Thread the nipple (G) into coupling on bottom of the frame (E) and secure it with the hex nut (F).
- 9. Raise the finial base (H) over the nipple (G) and thread the finial (I) onto the nipple (G).
- 10. Place the glass shade (D) into the frame (E)
- 11. Hook the end of arms (C) to the hook on the lamp body (B) and the arm of the frame (E).

Your installation is now complete. Return power to the junction box and test the fixture.
