



Install the Fixture



- Remove the diffuser from the fixture by turning it clockwise, then pulling out of the fixture.
- 2 Remove the mounting plate from the fixture by unscrewing the two thumb nuts from the inside of the fixture.
- 3 Secure the mounting plate to the electrical box with the #8-32 screws.
- 4 Connect the fixture to a suitable ground in accordance with local electrical codes.
- 5 Connect the white fixture wire to the neutral power line wire with a wire nut.
- 6 Connect the black fixture wire to the hot power line wire with a wire nut.
- 7 For 277V Only: If using 0-10V dimming, connect the purple and gray wires to a compatible dimmer. If not using 0-10V dimming, cap off the purple and gray wires.
- Neatly place all wires and wire nut connections inside the junction box, place the fixture onto the mounting studs, and secure it in place by screwing the thumb nuts onto the studs.
- Install the diffuser by aligning the slot on the diffuser with the peg in the fixture, inserting the diffuser into the fixture, and rotating clockwise to secure in place. Ensure that the diffuser is locked in place before releasing.
