This instruction shows a typical installation.




Use minimum 90°C supply conductors.

## **2 PERSON INSTALL**

#### Install the Fixture



- 1 Remove the mounting plate and driver from the canopy.
- Secure the mounting plate to ceiling using the #8-32 screws provided,
- Determine the desired height of the fixture using the provided stems and half ball/upper stem and assemble them by screwing them together. **Note:** the stem without a collar must be installed on the bottom of the stem assembly.
- 4 Slide the canopy, then the collar nut onto the half ball/stem assembly.
- 5 Feed the fixture wires through the stem assembly, then screw the stem assembly to the top of the fixture base.
- 6 Seat the half ball into the mounting plate ensuring no wires are being pinched.
- **7** Connect the black fixture wire to the negative (-) output driver wire with a wire nut.
- 8 Connect the red fixture wire to the positive (+) output driver wire with a wire nut.
- 9 Connect the fixture to a suitable ground in accordance with local electrical codes.
- 10 Connect the white input driver wire to the neutral power line wire with a wire nut.
- Connect the black input driver wire to the hot power line wire with a wire nut.
- **For 0-10V Dimming,** connect the purple and gray wires to a compatible dimmer. **If not using 0-10V dimming**, make sure to cap off these wires.
- Neatly place the driver, wire, and wire nut connections inside the canopy/junction box, then slide the canopy up over the mounting plate and secure in place with the collar nut.
- 14 Install the diffuser by screwing it at the end of the fixture arm. Repeat for any remaining diffusers.
