Use minimum 90°c supply conductors.



## **Install the Fixture**



- I Temporarily install the mounting plate to the junction box
- 2 Mark the anchor locations through the holes on the mounting plage. Remove the mounting plate.
- 3 Drill appropriate sized holes and install the anchors at the marked locations.
- 4 Secure the mounting plate to the junction box and screw the anchor screws through the anchors.
- 5 Connect the fixture to a suitable ground in accordance to local electrical codes.
- 6 Connect the white fixture wire (square and/or rigid) to the neutral power line wire with a wire nut.
- 7 Connect the black fixture wire (round and/or smooth) to the hot power line wire with a wire nut.
- 8 Neatly place all the wires into the junction box, place the canopy onto the mounting plate, and secure it in place using the fixture screws.
- Install the side glass panels by carefully inserting them in the frame and securing them using the small clips.
- Install the top glass panels by carefully inserting them in the cover and securing them using the large clips and clip screws.
- II Install the cover to the top of the frame using the cover screws.
- Slide the door glass panel into the door frame and secure it in place using the tabs.
- Install the candle tubes by sliding them over the sockets.
- Screw the lamps into the sockets. Refer to the label on the lamp socket for Max Wattage Information.
- 15 For wet locations, caulk around the base of the fixture with waterproof construction sealant.
