



Install the Fixture



- Determine which keyed holes on the mounting plate are compatible with your junction box.
- 2 Using the mounting plate holes compatible with your junction box, place the mounting plate slots over the screws. Rotate and hold the mounting plate while tightening the screws. **Note**: Do not over tighten screws as it may bend the mounting plate and cause the fixture to not sit flush.
- 3 Connect the fixture to a suitable ground in accordance to local electrical codes.
- 4 Connect the white fixture wire to the neutral power line wire with a wire nut.
- 5 Connect the black fixture wire to the hot power line wire with a wire nut.
- Align the slots on the fixture with the brackets on the mounting plate, push the fixture flush against the ceiling, and rotate it clockwise to lock in place. **Make sure the fixture is fully secured before releasing.**
- For wet locations, use 100% silicone to caulk 1/8" bead of silicone around the base of the fixture after it has been locked to the ceiling. Wait the designated silicone cure time before exposing the unit to wetness. Optionally: you can use Seagull Gasket # 620390 instead of silicone for wet locations.
