## **INSTRUCTIONS**

#### I. Preparing the Fixture

- 1. Separate the mounting plate from the fixture base by removing the fixture screws.
- 2. Install the mounting plate to the junction box and secure it using the mounting screws.

#### II. Wiring the Fixture

- 1. Safety first! Locate the circuit breaker and switch it off to cut off the power supply to the relevant circuits, ensuring that there is no electricity running through the wiring.
- 2. **GLO1181 only:** Install the steel cable to the mounting plate.
- 3. In accordance with local electrical codes, connect the fixture ground wire (bare copper or silver wire) to a suitable ground. This may be a green ground screw on the mounting plate, which the ground wire should be tightly wrapped around, or a house wire (green or bare copper wire without insulation).
- 4. Twist the bare ends of the following pairs of wires together using a wire nut to secure a connection:
  - a) Hot fixture wire (black) and hot power line wire from the junction box (hot to hot)
  - b) Neutral fixture wire (white) and neutral power line wire from the junction box (neutral to neutral)
- 5. Carefully tuck all the wires behind the mounting plate into the junction box.

#### III. Installing the Fixture

- 1. Mount the fixture base onto the mounting plate and secure it in place with the fixture screws.
- 2. Screw the bulb (not included) into the socket. Refer to the socket label for max wattage information.
- 3. Place the glass shade into the cage and secure it in place with the brackets and bracket screws.
- 4. Determine the preferred direction option of the cage assembly, with either one cage bar or two cage bars facing the front.
- 5. Install the cage assembly to the fixture base with the cage screws.
- 6. For wet locations, caulk around the base of the fixture with waterproof construction sealant.
