

ASSEMBLY & INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



Direct Burial Post, Round 390272, and Square 390172

CAUTION: FAILURE TO INSTALL THIS POST PROPERLY MAY RESULT IN SERIOUS PERSONAL INJURY OR DEATH AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. We recommend installation by a licensed electrician. This product must be installed in accordance with applicable installation code(s), by a person familiar with the construction and operation of the product and the hazards involved.*

To Install (Figure 1)

CAUTION: BE SURE POWER IS OFF AT THE MAIN BREAKER BOX PRIOR TO INSTALLATION.

SITE PREPARATION:

- 1. Run appropriate wiring to the site of the fixture, leaving enough excess wire to reach the top of the post, plus 12 inches.
- 2. Excavate a hole 12"-15" in diameter and approximately 20" deep or deeper depending on frost line in your area.
- 3. Add approximately 2" of gravel or crushed stone to the bottom of the hole for drainage.


INSTALLATION:

NOTE: Post may be cut to desired height before installation.

- 4. Insert wire into wireway hole 10" from the bottom of post leaving 12" extending beyond the top of the post.
- 5. Insert post in center of the hole bracing on 3 sides.
- 6. Pour concrete into hole leaving approximately 4" of space above concrete.

NOTE: Be careful not to allow concrete to enter the bottom of the post or wireway hole.

- 7. Allow concrete to harden before removing the braces.
- 8. Cover concrete with your surrounding top layer.
- 9. Follow individual fixture instructions to complete installation.
